

The Republican Clinical Perinatal Center was founded in January 2018 by combining the Republican Clinical Perinatal Center and Clinical Maternity Hospital No. 4 of the city of Ufa.

The Center with 530 beds is located in 3 buildings. The RCPC delivers medical care to pregnant women, women in childbirth, lying-in women and newborn children of a high risk group, including in cases of congenital malformation of a fetus, serious obstetric complications and somatic diseases of a mother, and to residents of cities and municipal districts of the Republic of Bashkortostan and the city of Ufa.

The institution may perform up to ten thousand deliveries every year and on average.

In 2018 21 774 women received treatment in the Perinatal Center, 9 603 newborn babies were delivered. 1 312 newborn babies were preterm, that is 39% of all preterm newborns of the Republic of Bashkortostan.

The RCPC is a center that renders a 3rd level medical care. The Center has X-ray units for temporary uterine arterial obstruction, modern endoscopy equipment and the majority of urgent operations is made in an organ preserving way. Whereas in such abnormalities as placenta praevia, placenta accreta, cervical pregnancy, women used to be hysterectomized in order to save lives, now it is possible to preserve an organ and save a patient's life by using X-ray surgical technologies and temporary uterine arterial obstruction. In the Reanimation and Transfusiology Department there are '*Cell Saver*' blood reinfusion devices, due to which operations are conducted as safe as possible and in a way that reduces blood loss.

All modern types of anesthesia are preformed, including epidural anesthesia during a delivery, by allowing women to go into a delivery comfortably and what is more important, painlessly.

Last year three heart vessel operations were conducted in the institution to children that weighed less than 1000 g. Early rehabilitation (abilitation) of newborns has been conducted jointly with the Fund of '*Gifted Children*' and volunteers since August.

The Republican Clinical Perinatal Center works together with the Bashkir State Medical University, Saint Petersburg State Pediatric University, and three institution-based chairs of the Bashkir State Medical University function, where future doctors (of Genetics, Anesthesiology and Reanimation, Obstetrics and Gynaecology) undergo training.
